

The **CCI-USA ANNUAL WORKSHOP** is an international gathering open to all who have completed basic co-counseling training. We meet to validate, discharge and re-evaluate using the co-counseling process. **WHEN:** The full workshop runs from Tuesday, May 5 (6 pm) to Sunday, May 10 (1:30 pm).

*We strongly encourage you to attend the full workshop. It makes a difference for you and for the other attendees. There may be options, however, if you wish to attend part-time. Newcomers to the workshop or alums can attend Tuesday through Friday. Alums can also opt for Friday through Sunday, or to commute. Part-time spaces are limited and are on a first-come, first-served basis. An **early bird discount** of \$25 is available if your registration form is postmarked on or before March 5, 2020.

To qualify for the early bird discount, please enclose a **50% deposit** with your registration form, or attach a detailed payment plan. Checks or money orders should be made out to CCI-USA and be in U.S. dollars.

**Full payment** for U.S. co-counselors is due by April 11, 2020. (International co-counselors may pay their balance at the workshop.)

Limited **FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE** is available to help as many people as possible attend. If you need a bursary, please indicate the amount needed on your registration form. Postmark it no later than March 5, 2020. A member of the bursary committee will contact you to discuss your request and available resources. Bursary grants are generally limited to 50% of the shared room/shared bath rate, but if you need more, let us know.

**CONTRIBUTIONS** to the Bursary Fund are greatly appreciated and fully tax deductible. Your contribution enriches the workshop by helping others to attend.

**IMPORTANT TO KNOW:**

- Recreational use of drugs or alcohol is not permitted during the workshop, including during free time. Smoking is restricted to a designated outdoor space.
- Children are welcome at the venue, but there is no formal program for them. Their participation in workshop activities is limited unless they have completed Fundamentals. Parents/guardians are responsible to provide or arrange supervision for them.
